

# Peas

**Botanical Name:** Papilionaceae  
**Family Name:** Pea & Bean

## Growing Conditions:

**Soil preparation:** Dig in 3 inches of aged manure or compost.

**Planting times:** Seed early spring; plant every 2 weeks until early May.

**Planting instructions:** Mark your row with the handle of your hoe, place in the pea seeds and then cover with soil.

**Spacing:** Seed 2 inches apart 1 inch deep.

**Watering:** Peas suffer from heat and drought and require regular water.

**Fertilizing:** Do so after a heavy bloom and pods are starting to set.

**Stake:** Use netting so peas will grow upright.
